  of the semester.
- If your student cannot attend makeup weeks, no additional makeups or refunds will be provided.

## **STUDENT CONDUCT EXPECTATIONS**

- Arriving on time, focused, and ready to participate
- Speaking kindly to instructors and fellow students
- No foul language, bullying, name-calling, or inappropriate jokes

- If issues continue, we will contact the parent/guardian.
